Through the sports funding, we were fortunate to be able to provide all sports and activity related clubs free of charge to all pupils. This included golf clubs that were sometimes attended by a local professional, football clubs, netball clubs and dance clubs. By funding these clubs, more children were able to take part in extra-curricular sports.

We also used some of the money to update some of our sports equipment which is used in PE lessons and at playtimes. This means that our children are now more active at playtimes and are improving their skills in a variety of different activities. Storage was also updated so equipment was kept safe and easily accessible. We invested in:

- New tri-golf equipment for 10 children
- New football, tennis balls, netballs and airflow balls
- New basic equipment for any general PE lesson
- New football equipment including; footballs, corner flags, bibs, gloves and drinks bottles for the school team
- New storage systems for all of the new sporting equipment
